1. College beautification and campus cleaning drive on 4th April 2023: The students of NSS had joined College beautification and campus cleaning drive on the 4th April 2023. Total 9 NSS students participated in this drive. Students helped others to put sign boards in the college campus, and cleaning the staff room, garden, segregation of the plastic and so on were done by the students.



2. Conduction of Survey from 12th April 2023 to 23rd April 2023: The students joined a survey organized by the Central Government and SPPU for youth to learn more about how the youth of India live with either currently not enrolled in formal education or regular employment. The students held the survey from 12th April 2023 to 23rd April 2023. 20 students participated in this survey. They have filled the questionnaire from the eligible people age group 15- 29 years.

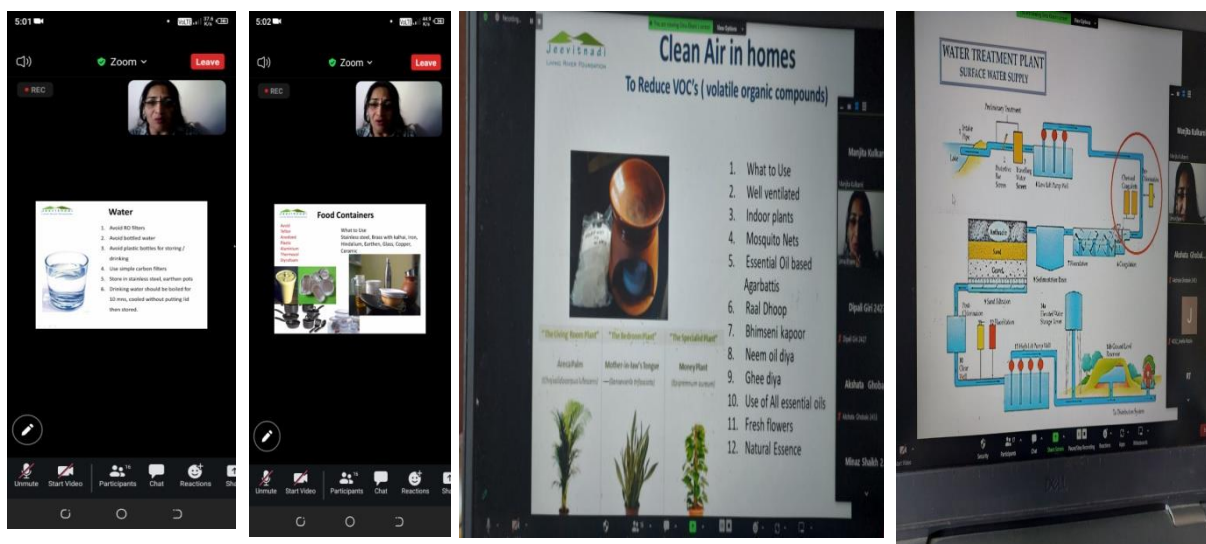


3. Paryavaran Purak Jeevanshaili_ Toxin free lifestyle - Guest Lecture by Ms. Uma Khare on 16th May 2023: The students organized and attended a guest lecture about connection to G-20 3rd Energy Transition Working Group(ETWG) meeting titled “Paryavaran Purak Jeevanshaili- Toxin free lifestyle” on 16th May 2023. Mrs. Uma Khare from Jeevitnadi foundation had taken this lecture stating the importance of environment in our life. She has explained the natural cycle of water and how we pollute our environment through our



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daily routine. She explained the chemical reaction of all the products which we use in our daily routine specially cosmetics and how they effect on our health. Lastly she talked on the alternative measures which can be useful for our daily lifestyle where we can stop polluting our environment and preserve good health. For example- organic cosmetics, detergents and natural ingredients which we can use. For this session total 16 participants were there.



4. Participated in international yoga day 21st June 2023: The 9th

International Yoga Day was celebrated by St. Mira's College for Girl's, Pune in Hybrid mode both offline and virtually due to vacations. To create awareness of yoga among the students and staff, the Department of Physical Education had organised Practical Session along with Yoga Pyramids Demonstration of students. Total 86 students and 24 staff members actively participated offline in college campus and Google meet platform. This year the theme of the Yoga Day was "Yoga for Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam". - a) **Anti-Drug pledge**-Total 20 students have taken the government pledge that they will not consume any type of tobacco products in their live.



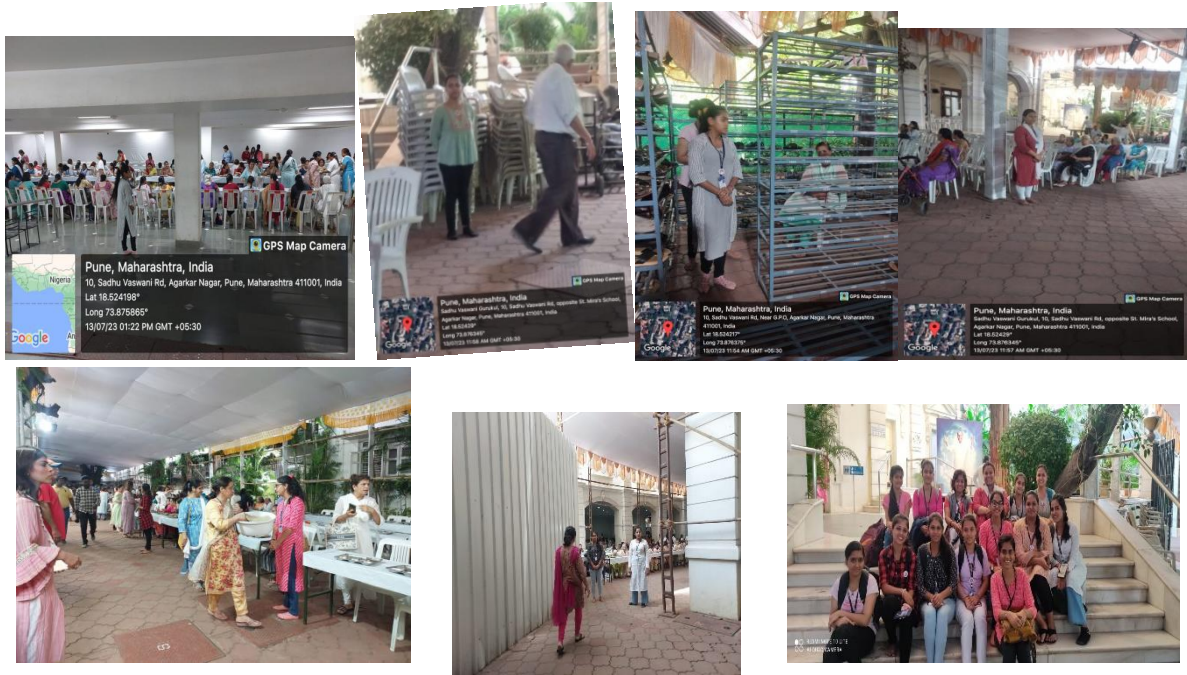

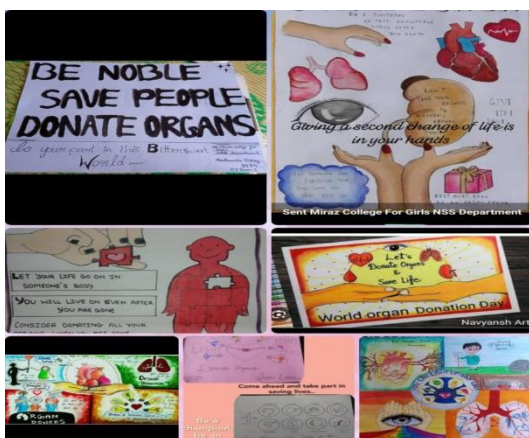
13. 105th Rev. Dada J.P. Vaswani's 105th Birth Anniversary, Mission Seva 2nd August, 2023-

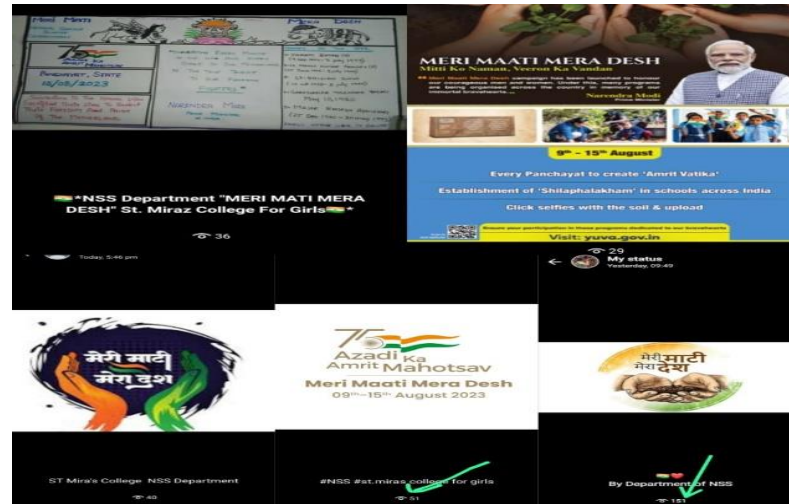

3. Discussion about participation of young voters in democracy for FYBA Class and making posters for the Voter Registration Drive- Department of Politics and Public Administration.

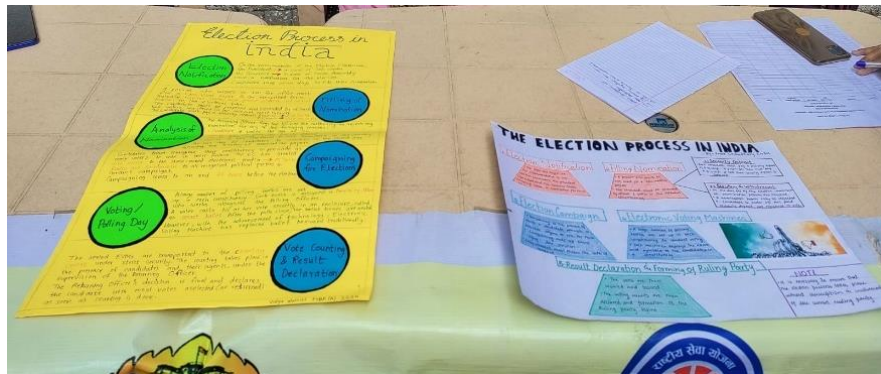

On this occasion following activities were conducted.

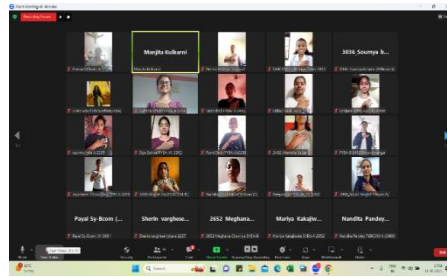

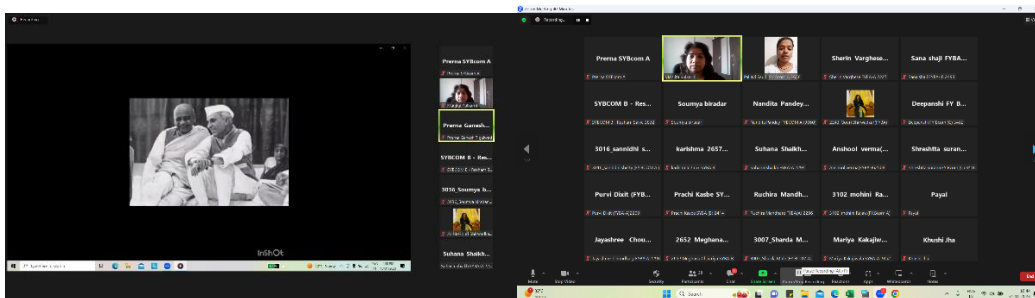
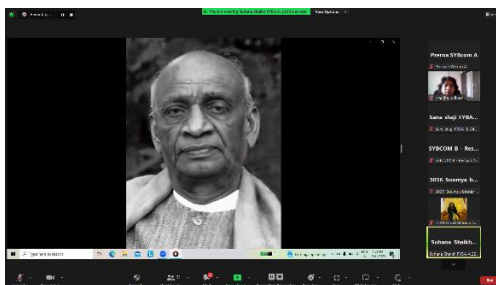
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2. Life Sketch of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel-

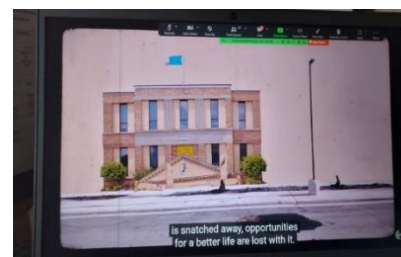
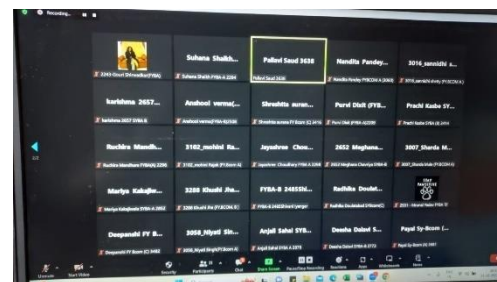
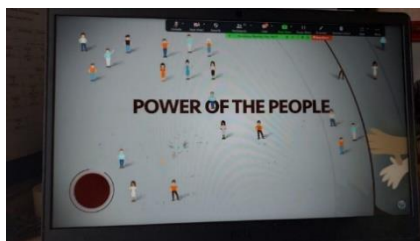


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November 2023. Totally, 34 students took part in this activity and the total number of views they received were 2834.

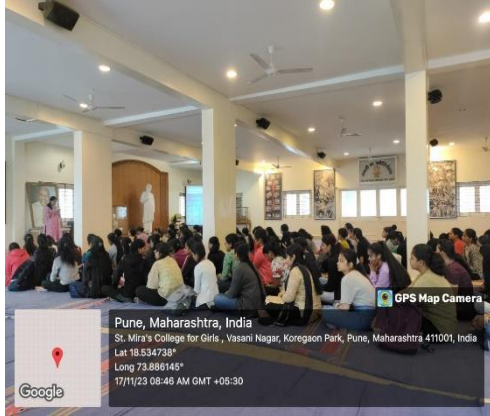

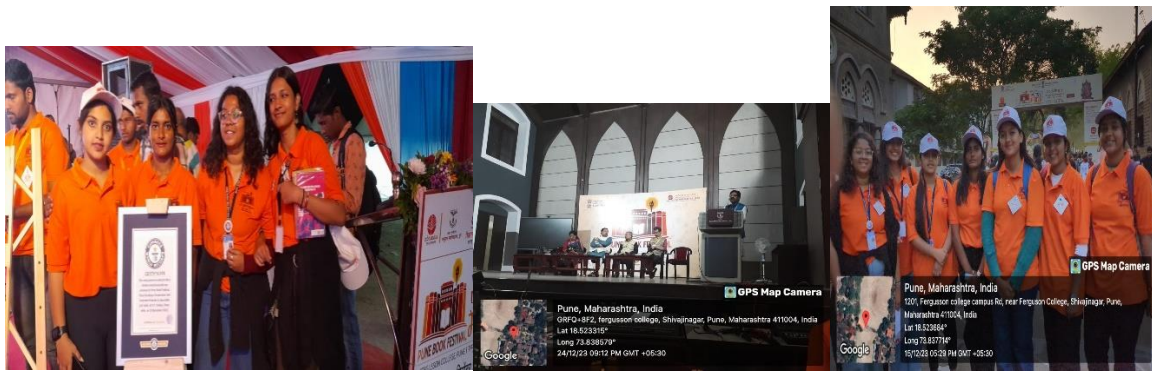

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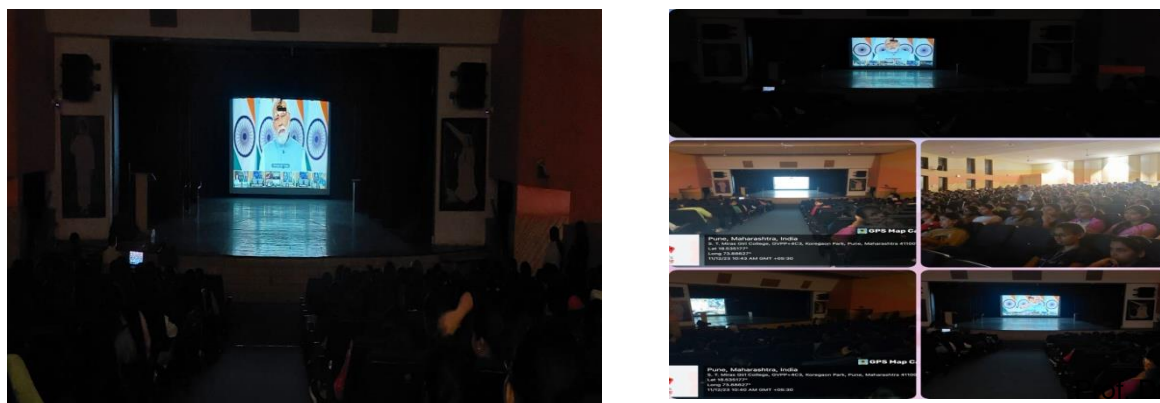
