Curriculum framework of NEP 2020:

Major Subject: Under the Department Specific Core subject framework, the student selects one Major/Core subject. Disciplinary Major courses are offered to assure in-depth study of particular subjects.

Minor Subject: In order to gain additional domain knowledge in one more subject, the student has to select one Minor subject.

Open Elective (OE): A comprehensive basket of open elective courses is offered to ensure multi disciplinary exposure.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): Mandatory Courses on content related to Linguistics and Communication Skills in English and Hindi/Marathi.

Vocational Skill Course (VSC): A basket of vocational skill courses is designed to impart vocational and soft skills and hands-on training. These courses aim to enhance the employability of students.

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC): Courses aimed at imparting practical skills, and soft skills to ensure overall personality development of students.

On-Job Training (OJT)/Internship/Field Project (FP)/Community Engagement Programme (CEP) Research Project (RP): Application of knowledge/concepts in solving or analyzing a real-life problem. This component is related to the Major subject.

Co-curricular Course (CC): For the holistic development of students through co-curricular courses, specific courses related to Yoga, Sports and physical training are offered.

Value Education Course (**VEC**): Courses designed to develop values and a sense of ethics. The courses combine modern values and ethical view derived from Indian tradition.

Indian Knowledge System (IKS): IKS courses aim to give students orientation in India's rich heritage.

The tables below contain the planned quantum of courses that will be offered under the Arts, Commerce (grant-in-aid) and Science (non-grant) programs starting from June 2023. The total credits that a student will collect in each semester is 22. A student is free to exit at the end of each academic year as depicted in the table below.

On successful completion of three years and obtaining 132 credits, a student can opt for an exit with a bachelor's degree in their domain, e.g., B.Sc./B.A./B.Com/BBA/CA.

On successful completion of the UG fourth year (PG I) and obtaining 176 credits, a student will get a Bachelor's Degree with Honors.

If a student opts for an Honors degree by Research, the eligibility criteria will beat the discretion of the College.

Dr. Vaishali Joshi welcomed all the members. The following items on the agenda were discussed in the meeting.

Agenda 1: To decide the NEP credit structure.



Resolution: It was decided to have a common credit structure for Arts and Commerce. Common Credit structure attached.

- 1. It was decided to follow the credit structure as per GR dated 20th April 2023 with minor modifications.
- 2. It was decided to have 4 credit minor paper at FY level in both the semesters; Minor paper at SY level will be of 2 credits per semester.
- 3. It was decided to have 2 IKS- 2credit generic IKS at FY level and 2 credit subject specific IKS at SY level.
- 4. FY sem 1 SEC shifted to SY to balance the total credits.
- 5. +2 credits to be added to Major subject at TY level to maintain criteria of minimum 50 % credits of major category.
- 6. St. Mira's to have a credit structure of combined 132 credits for all the three years.

Agenda 2: To decide the workload of all the faculties.

Resolution: It was decided that -

- 1. The workload of existing 20 lectures per week per person was converted to new workload using the formula no of current lectures(per week) * 50 minutes / 60 minutes
- 2. Workload of minimum 16 and maximum 20 lectures per week per person to be followed.
- 3. It was decided to protect the workload of every faculty in the college.
- Business Eco dept, Accounts dept, Mathematics Hindi, Marathi and History departments.
 - 5. To protect workload it was decided to offer separate Minor subjects for Arts and Commerce; but common OE basket for both.
 - 6. It was decided to have separate departmental meetings to discuss and finalize workload.
 - 7. It was decided to have 60 minutes lectures for all the years FY/SY and TY to maintain the uniformity and smoothen the time table process.
 - 8. It was decided to have one NEP core committee and subcommittees for admissions, ABC implementation, ABC sensitization and Syllabus framing involving each faculty in one or the other committee.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by the Coordinator, NEP Committee.

Agenda 1: To decide the NEP credit structure for Commerce.

Resolution: It was decided that

- 1. The Commerce department will follow the same common credit structure.
- 2. The credit structure for FYBCOM was discussed in detail.
- 3. The tentative credit structure and subject baskets for SYBCOM and TYBCOM were discussed too.

Agenda 2: To decide the subject baskets for FYBCOM.

Resolution: It was decided that -

- 1. Commerce will offer five (BA, BE, Marketing, Banking and Costing) subjects as Majors.
- 2. Business Economics and Accounts will be put under Minor category;
- 3. 13 arts and commerce subjects have been put under Open Elective,



- 4. Quantitative Aptitude, Social Media and Digital Literacy and Computer Applications will be put under VSC.
- 5. Understanding India and Democracy under VEC, English under AEC for FY, IKS, and sports and NSS under CC.

Agenda 3: To decide the workload.

Resolution:

- 1. It was decided to calculate workload as 16 lectures per person per week.
- 2. Maths was included in VSC and OE to protect the workload.
- 3. IT subject has been given a place in VSC.
- 4. To protect the workload of the English department, English was put under OE, VSC, VEC and AEC.
- 5. Dr. Minakshi Wagh will have workload in both the departments Business Economics and Accounts.

Agenda 4: To decide about the subjects and workload of Business Economics and Accounts.

Resolution: It was decided to put Economics and Accounts subjects under Minor category as options to each other. To protect the workload of both the departments it was decided to have one division each for both the subjects and one combined division.

Agenda 5: To discuss and finalize the commerce credit structure, subjects and workload.

Resolution: It was decided that commerce faculties will have more meetings about the subjects, credit structure and workload of all commerce faculties and submit final subjects and workload by 22nd May 2023.

- 9. OE courses will be offered as OE3 and OE4. These OE baskets will be conveyed to Ms. Swati Pulate in advance for facilitating timetable 2024-25.

Agenda 2: To decide the deadlines for submission of 1st draft of the syllabi and the titles of the syllabi of SY NEP.

Resolution:

- 1. Titles of all the SY NEP courses to be submitted to C1 by 26th Feb 2024.

Agenda 1: To discuss about the difficulties and issues faced by the staff in implementing the NEP at first year.

Resolution: The faculty members in the Arts stream faced following problems in implementing NEP at FY level –

- 1. Implementing the wide-spread time table was found difficult with increasing student absentees.
- 2. English department proposed for 12th English subject marks as the cut-off for admission in English VSC and OE.
- 3. The issue of OEs (in Marathi language) to be offered to Marathi medium students was raised.
- 4. Faculties suggested to reshuffle existing OE baskets to accommodate Marathi medium students well. Offering basic computer related skills under OE for all the students can be considered as an option for Marathi medium students.
- 5. Hindi and Marathi departments are having 200 plus and 150 plus students in their SEC classes respectively. This is affecting the smooth conduct of the classes adversely.
- 6. Students of OE subjects should be decided in advance as this is essential for syllabus framing.
- 7. Current 16 OEs will be retained at FY level.



- 8. It was decided to have total 12 OEs at SY level and these OEs will be kept open to all the streams.
- 9. The tedious CO-PO mapping work was discussed in the light of the decision of keeping OEs open to all.
- 10.It was decided that IKS, VEC and AECs will not have only internal evaluation but they will also be evaluated in End-sem exam.

Resolution: The faculty members in the Commerce stream faced following problems in implementing NEP at FY level –

Details

Dr. Vaishali Joshi informed everyone about new credit framework suggested by the Govt of Maharashtra and S.P.P.U. Dr. Jaya Rajagopalan expressed her concern about difficulties arising out of constant changes and proposed to complete a cycle of three years with the current credit structure.
