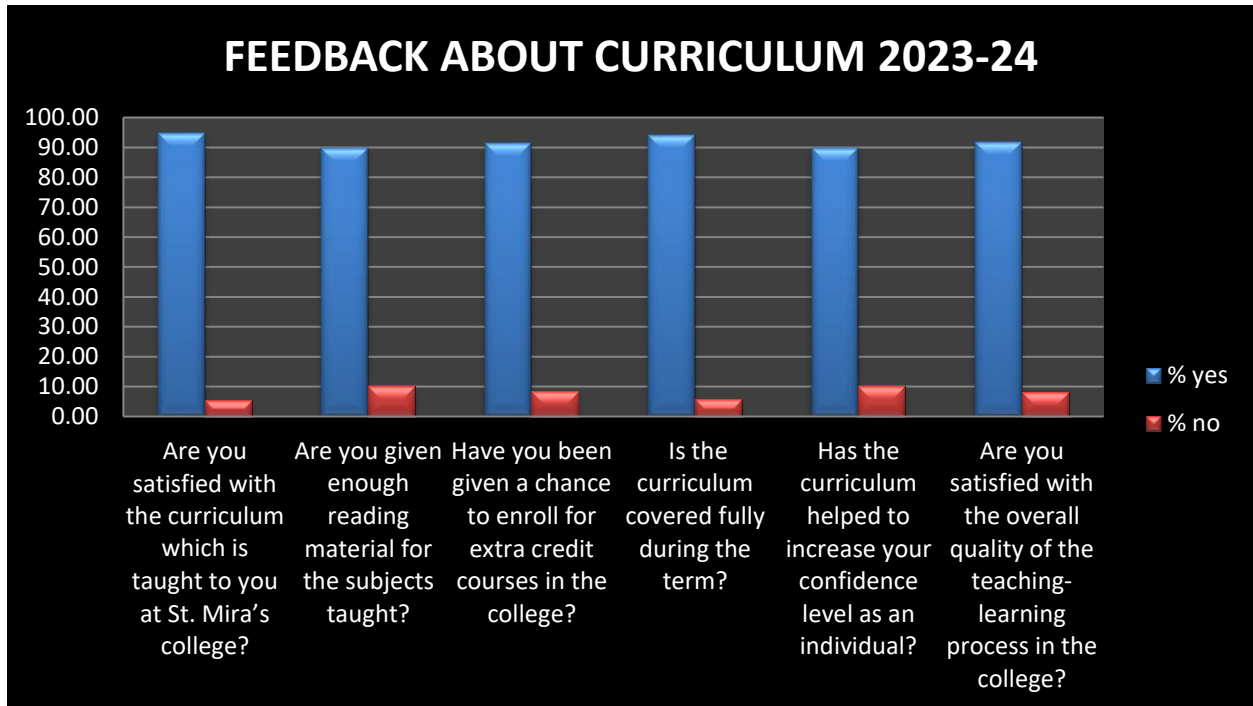


STUDENT FEEDBACK ON CURRICULLUM AND TEACHERS

94.66 % students expressed that they were satisfied with the curriculum which is taught to them at St. Mira's college.

89.85 % students felt that they were given enough reading material for the subjects taught.

91.57 % students stated that they have been given a chance to enroll for extra credit courses in the college.

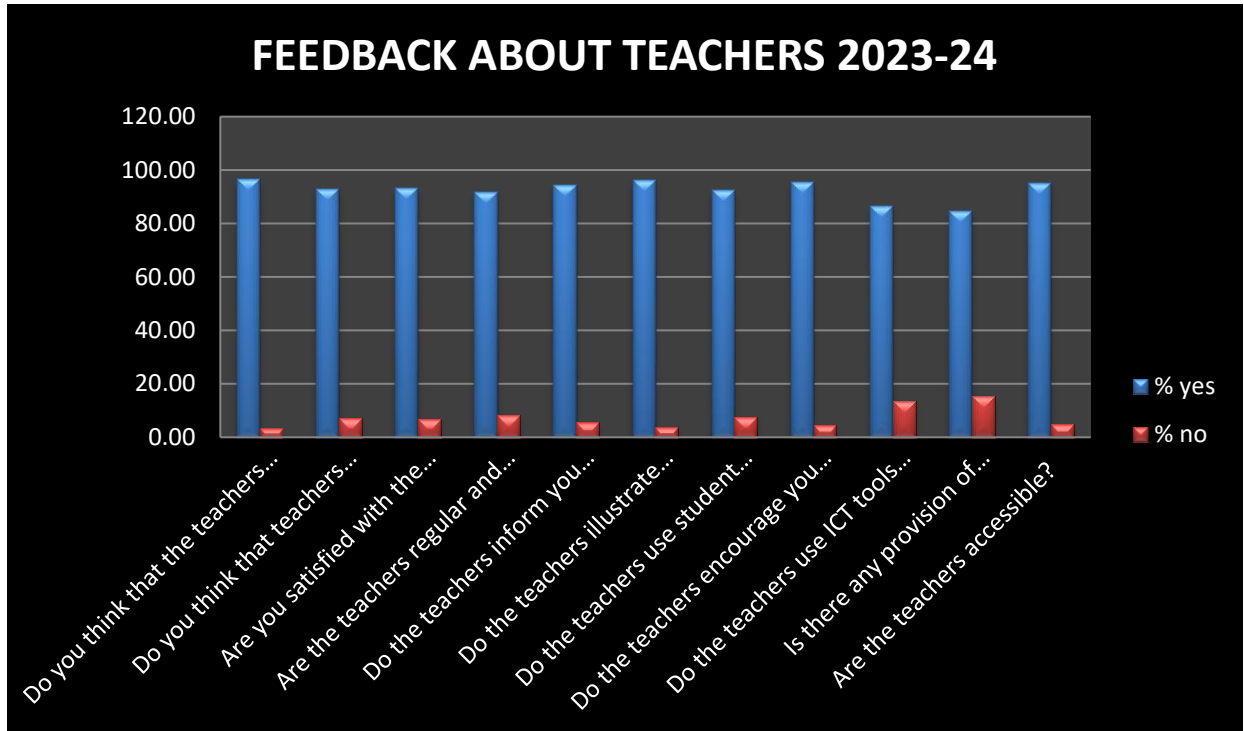
94.15 % opined that the curriculum was covered fully during the term.

91.74 % students stated that they were satisfied with the overall quality of the teaching-learning process in the college.



II) FEEDBACK ABOUT TEACHERS 2023-24



ANALYSIS: FEEDBACK ABOUT TEACHERS 2023-24

96.73 % students opined that the teachers prepare well for classes.

92.94 % students expressed that teachers communicate effectively.

93.12 % students are satisfied with the teachers' approach to teaching.

91.74 % students felt that the teachers are regular and punctual.

94.49 % students affirmed that the teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

96.39 % students stated that the teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications.

92.43 % students opined that the teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential, learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

95.52 % students were of the view that the teachers encourage you to participate in extra curricular activities.



86.40 % students stated that the teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

84.51 % students felt that there a provision of sufficient time for revision.

95.18 % students affirmed that teachers are accessible.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2023-24

Stakeholder feedback analysis undertaken in 2022-23

This Action Taken Report has been compiled in 2023-24, based on the Complete Stakeholder feedback analysis exercise undertaken in 2022-23. It is with pride that we state that the stakeholders offered a positive feedback (mostly above 90%). The constructive suggestions offered mainly by students and parents covered the following:

I CURRICULUM:

1. Introduction of a study of Foreign Languages.

The students of all streams are extended the facility of exposure to extra value added courses in German and Spanish as per popular demand.

2. Need for a wide variety of Post Graduate courses.

The College offers Post-graduate Programs in Arts, (M.A. English, Sociology, Economics), M.Com (Business Administration and Advanced Accountancy) and MSc (CS). These programs are available on campus in online mode (Part I) and offline mode (Part II).

Besides, the College (Dept of Psychology) organized and conducted Post Graduate Diploma Courses in Dance Movement Therapy, Clinical Music Therapy and Mindfulness based Counselling for outside students.

3. Need to upgrade Political Science syllabus.

The Political Science Head of Department has been intimated about the same. In any case, the College goes in for a Curriculum redesign every three years.

The College adopted the NEP 2020 credit structure in 2023 wherein the First Year (all streams) went in for a curriculum restructuring as per the NEP credit structure.



The timeline for curriculum revision and implementation for the four year Degree Program (BA, BCom, BBA, BBA (CA), and BSc (CS)] is as follows:

This revision will include the up gradation of curriculum of all courses as well.

4. Addition of Political Science Special.

The College offers Political Science as an optional subject at the General level with the course title as: **Politics and Public Administration**. Under the NEP credit structure, implemented in our College at the First-Year level w.e.f. 2023-24 onwards, we have the opportunity to offer our General subjects like Politics and Public Administration as Minor subjects (for BA Program) and as Open Electives across streams, thus extending the reach of the course and making the offering, more inter-disciplinary in nature.

5. Curriculum found to be too overwhelming:

For academic enrichment it is important that curriculum across streams remains robust and intensive. The College is vigilant about the challenges faced and academic stress experienced by the students through the Mentoring sessions by assigned Faculty Mentors. The students are also provided opportunities for alternate assessment patterns, in case the need arises.

6. Permit Double Majoring.

This suggestion needs careful deliberation and can be considered in the near future subject to securing of the necessary permissions from the Office of the Directorate of Higher Education and the affiliating Savitribai Phule Pune University.



7. Request for increased opportunities for participation in extra-curricular activities and credit courses

The College aims to bring about the holistic development of the students. Hence, students are encouraged to participate in extra-curricular activities like Declamation, Poetry Recitation, Elocution, Debate, Poster-making, Bhajan, Rangoli Competitions, and Dada-Leela on the life of revered Founder Sadhu T.L. Vaswani and beloved Dada J.P. Vaswani, Krishna Prashna Manch Sports activities. They are also motivated to engage in value added credit courses conducted on campus. Students are informed of such events via the College Website, through class WhatsApp groups and class announcements. Post graduate credit courses are conducted in an online mode, available in a self-paced manner so as to offer flexibility to the students.
