ACTION TAKEN:

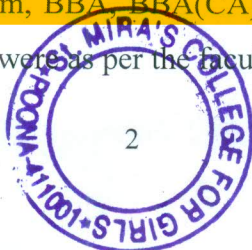
The Meeting commenced with an Opening Prayer. The Principal In-charge, Dr. Jaya Rajagopalan welcomed the esteemed external Academic Council members.

Item No. 1: The Minutes of the previous Emergent and Special Meeting of the Academic Council, held on Sat. 29-04-2023 were read and confirmed:

- (i) Welcome to the new external members of the newly constituted Academic Council;
- (ii) Activation of the NEP Implementation Cell at College;
- (iii) Activating the process of NEP implementation at College, with immediate effect;
- (iv) Stating of the DSC Major Option under the NEP, 2020, as selected by the College;
- (v) affirmation by the College to develop course groupings as per the faculty wise Baskets of all 6 verticals viz. (i) Major(ii) Minor, (iii) Generic/Open Elective Courses(iv) Vocational and Skill Enhancement Courses (VSEC); (v) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Indian Knowledge System (IKS) and Value Education Courses (VEC); (vi) Field Projects / internship / apprenticeship / community engagement and service corresponding to the Major Subject, Co-curricular Courses and Research Project and their combinations;
- (vi) Affirmative action to be taken for sensitizing the stakeholders on effective implementation of new curricular framework under the NEP.
- (vii) Hosting of an Emergent Academic Council Meeting for approval of the same;
- (viii) Intimating the Directorate of Higher Education, Govt of Maharashtra and the affiliating parent university, Savitribai Phule Pune University regarding the same;

The aforesaid points covered in the Academic Council meeting on 29-04-2023 were in conformance with the Government of Maharashtra Resolution dated 20-04-2023, for implementation in the academic year 2023-2024. The previous Minutes dated 29-04-2023 were read and confirmed.

Item No.2: Following the Government of Maharashtra Resolution dated 20-04-2023 regarding adoption of National Education Policy(NEP), 2020, the credit structure and syllabi of the Undergraduate Programs (B.A, B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA), B.Sc.(CS) for the First Year level, was presented. The course groupings were as per the faculty wise Baskets of all 6 verticals viz.



(i) Major(ii) Minor, (iii) Generic/Open Elective Courses, (iv) Vocational and Skill Enhancement Courses (VSEC); (v) Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Indian Knowledge System (IKS) and Value Education Courses (VEC); (vi) Field Projects / internship / apprenticeship / community engagement and service corresponding to the Major Subject, Co-curricular Courses and Research Project and their combinations.

Dr. V Joshi raised a query regarding a 4credit allocation, per semester in the Minor vertical at the First Year level. This query was resolved by Principal In-charge, Dr Jaya Rajagopalan, who opined that the exchange of FY Minor credits (2) with SY Minor credits (4), offered more choice at the First Year level. Since, the credit structure cited in the Government of Maharashtra Resolution dated 20-04-2023 was illustrative and permitted flexibility in credit allocation, within the specified minimum and maximum limits, the same was approved by the Academic Council.

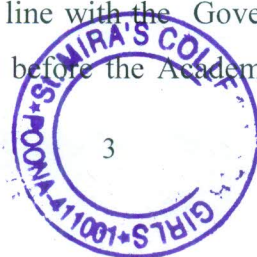
Dr. Gidwani suggested that in the B.A. credit structure, an Open Elective on Artificial Intelligence could be introduced which would be interdisciplinary in nature. This suggestion was welcomed by the Principal In-charge, Dr. Jaya Rajagopalan who opined that the same would be offered as part of the subject basket at the Second Year level.

Dr. Gidwani highlighted the importance and employability potential of the subject of Accountancy in a BCom Program. Dr Jaya Rajagopalan emphasized that Accountancy and Business Economics were being offered as optional courses under the Minor vertical. This was because, in the pre-NEP structure, the two subjects were core subjects. But under the NEP structure, work load considerations surfaced, which made it imperative to retain both the courses, with an internal option between the two in the Minor vertical. This view was accepted by the Academic Council.

Dr. Meena Chandawarkar suggested further deepening of the Open Elective basket of subjects by including a foreign language. Dr Jaya Rajagopalan endorsed that the College offers foreign languages like Spanish and German as value added courses, which feature in the student marksheet but welcomed the idea of their inclusion as an Open Elective, at the SY level, in view of the fact that the study of a foreign language brings with it an opportunity for global exposure to students.

Dr. Vinayak Joshi enquired about IKS for BBA(CA). Mrs. Rekha Kankariya communicated that Major Specific IKS (Indian knowledge System) is included at the Second Year level.

The first year syllabi of the B.A, B.Com, BBA, BBA(CA) and BSc(CS) and the NEP subject baskets as per the College structure in line with the Government of Maharashtra Resolution dated 20-04-23, which were presented before the Academic Council, were approved by the



same, subject to minor changes, if any, as recommended by the Academic Council.

Item No.3: The College informed the Academic Council of its intent to upload the BOS and Academic Council approved syllabi of the First Year Undergraduate Programs of B.A, B.Com, BBA, BBA (CA), BSc (CS), on the Portal of the Savitribai Phule Pune University. The same was accepted and approved by the Academic Council.

Item No.4: The College informed the esteemed Academic Council members, its decision of sensitizing the stakeholders via Orientation in offline and online mode, via website notifications, social media platforms/handles, use of promotional resources, for effective implementation of new curricular framework under the NEP. The same was approved by the Academic Council.

Item no 5: The College assured the Academic Council, that the affiliating Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Maharashtra would be intimated about the approval of the First-Year syllabi at the Special Academic Council Meeting, held on Monday, 05-06-2023. This intimation would take the form of an Action Taken Report (ATR) covering all items covered in this Special Academic Council Meeting. The aforesaid item was read and approved by the Academic Council.

Item No. 6: No other agenda was taken up for discussion.

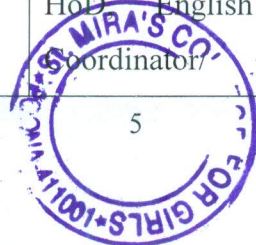
The Meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks and a closing Prayer by Mrs. Rekha Kankariya, Coordinator, and Self-financing Courses.

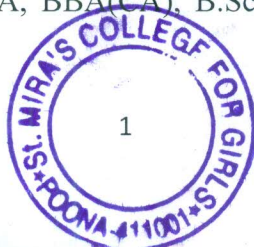
ACTION TAKEN:

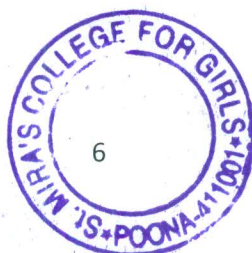

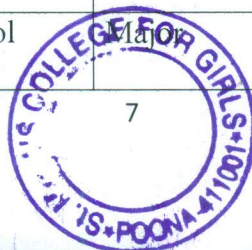

The following suggestions were made by the external Academic Council members:

1. Curriculum framing inputs from Students:

Dr Meena Chandawarkar while appreciating the MA Sociology syllabus, suggested that curriculum inputs from students would help in reframing curriculum in Sem 2, if required. This suggestion was welcomed by the Principal In charge.

2. Departmental Newsletter:

Dr Meena Chandawarkar enquired if the College had a departmental newsletter. Dr Rama Venkat, HoD, Commerce stated that the Centre for Women Entrepreneurs had a coffee table book publication titled 'Zenith'. Dr Chandawarkar suggested that the same could be converted into an ISBN publication-a suggestion which was welcomed by all.

3. Variety of Electives:

Prof. Vinayak Joshi suggested that for the MSc(CS) Program, the College could provide more electives and give generic titles to courses eg: 'Emerging Technologies ----' which could be allow for flexibility in curriculum to include recent developments from time to time based on demand of industry.

He added that a provisioning for a variety of electives could be done to enable students to access areas of study like 'Quantum Computing' via offerings of NPTEL or SWAYAM courses.

Ms. Priya Patil, Industry expert enquired as to the scope of Cloud Computing and whether **Dev Ops** were covered in the curriculum. She stressed on its inclusion as an elective for MSc (CS).

Dr. Meena Chandawarkar suggested that an online course on Digital Fluency could be introduced. Principal In-charge, Dr Jaya Rajagopalan agreed that these were indeed good suggestions.

No further suggestions were made with respect to curriculum were received from the Academic Council via email.

4. OJT Framework:

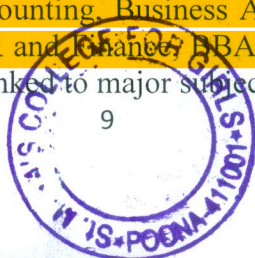
Prof. Vinayak Joshi also enquired whether the College had framed any guidelines for On the Job Training (OJT). Dr. Shalini Iyer, Vice Principal replied that since OJT was applicable for all PG Programs, that OJT framework/guidelines/policy document would be laid out as soon as possible.

Ms. Gitanjali Phadnis proposed that summer time would be considered as time frame for conduct of OJT. Prof Vinayak Joshi opined that if OJT was undertaken in summer, the PG results would get delayed . hence, the time frame for conduct of OJT should be reconsidered.

He suggested that the College could combine OJT (which was a pre-training for Internship/Research Projects) and Research Projects for practical purpose. Industry will be ready to do accommodate students for the same. For academic and evaluation purposes, the same could be shown under two heads.

Dr Jaya Rajagopalan, Principal In charge appreciated these suggestions and requested Prof Joshi to provide leads in internships and employment of the industry; She stated that the OJT Framework would be presented to the members at the next Academic Council Meeting.

Item No.5: The revised syllabi for the +2 credits linked to the Major courses [in UG] for all streams for implementation in Sem I, of the academic year 2023-24, was presented. The details of the same related to the B.A. with specializations in Sociology, Economics, English and Psychology, B.Com with specializations in Banking & Finance, Cost and Works Accounting, Business Administration, Business Entrepreneurship, Marketing, BBA with specializations in HR and Finance, BBA(Computer Applications, B.Sc. 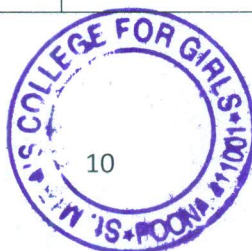

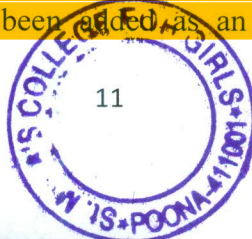

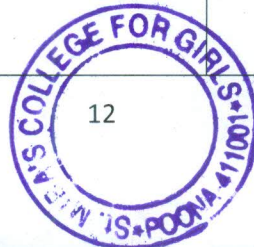
The consecutive meeting was tentatively scheduled to be held in November, 2023.

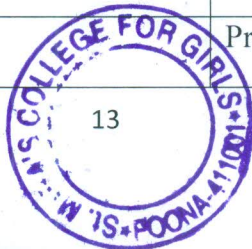
