Dr Yan Yang from the Department of Art History, Burough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC), New York and Dr Snober Sataravala, Department of English St Mira's College for Girls collaborated on the course MILE: Art and Violence. The course began with introductory sessions known as ice breakers posted on SLACK. The course consisted of 4 synchronous and 1 asynchronous lecture conducted every Saturday. The first lecture was conducted on 2nd February 2023 by Dr Yan Yang who addressed the theme exploring violence in ancient western art and middle eastern art. In the second asynchronous session Prof Radhika Seshan lectured the students on Mughal paintings. She elaborated on the use of colour, the subjects of the paintings and the division of the canvas linking it to the theme art and violence. The next lecture was on 9th February 2023 by an artist Mena Malgonkar who shared her aesthetic approach and understanding of violence in modern Indian art. The next synchronous lecture on 23rd February 2023 was by Kisalay Vora who shared his art and the use of bangles in depicting violence towards women. The concluding lecture was by Dr Yang on violence and Christian art on the 2nd of March 2023. The students were divided into groups and collaborated on their assignments. They reinterpreted works of art, made 2 minute videos on what they learnt and wrote collaborative commentary on art. The digital platform used was SLACK.

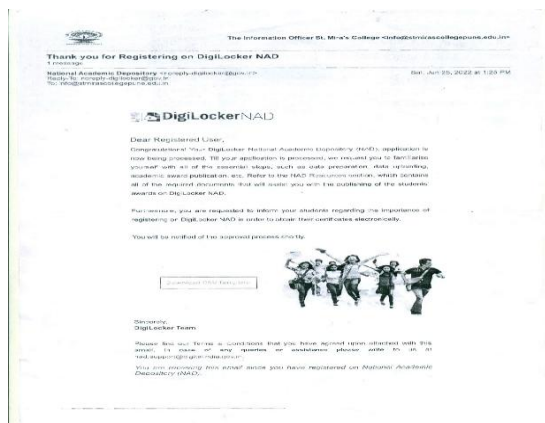
