The academic year 2023-24, as usual, was a year brimming with a plethora of exciting events. Here goes a quick round up of the college activities for this year:

I. Our Quality Initiatives

The various special programmes which form a part of our quality initiatives during the academic year include the following:

St. Mira's College's Department of Psychology's initiative, the Mental Well-Being Program, received the Torchbearer Award by IDA Awards- Education 2023 in the Higher Education Category.



- Post-graduate Diploma in Dance Movement Therapy-The College in collaboration with Artsphere and academic consultants The Art Therapist Collab (TATC) introduced a post-graduate diploma in Dance Movement Therapy.


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structure which includes awareness sessions, group therapy and individual counseling. The initiation of Raahi-The Student led club received a lot of positive feedback.

Mira International Learning Exchange: A Centre for Virtual Collaboration arose out of its rewarding interaction with LaGuardia Community College, City University of New York and its programme titled COIL: Collaborative Online International Learning which "allows faculty partners in different parts of the world to develop a shared curricular

project and engage their students using online tools (synchronous and asynchronous)." In 2023-24, the department of English along with the department of Politics conducted a MILE course, "Comparative Perspectives on Gender Inequality in India and the US" with the University of Florida. The Department of English also conducted a course MILE: The Achievement of Desire with the Linguistics Dept, Borough of Manhattan Community College.

• Deeksharambh – Student Induction Programme

The Deeksharambha Committee organized the SIP from July 5 to July 13, 2023, for first-year students of all streams. Its aim was to acquaint them with the college campus and foster rapport among peers and teachers. The six-day program merged play and learning for an enriching experience. It began with a prayer and welcome address by Dr. Jaya Rajagopalan, acting Principal, introducing institutional traditions. Mrs. Ekta Jadhav led a Yoga session emphasizing fitness. The Green Club showcased environmental initiatives, hosting a slogan writing contest. Dr. Vaishali Joshi introduced Sadhu T.L. Vaswani and Dada J.P. Vaswani, founders of Sadhu Vaswani Mission. The day concluded with a Cultural Programme.





Day two began with Dr. Snober Satarvala, IQAC Coordinator, presenting on the Institution's Autonomous status, curriculum, and the upcoming implementation of the National Education Policy (NEP) from 2023-24. Mrs. Geetanjali Phadnis introduced mentoring sessions' significance. Dr. Vaishali Diwakar, Controller of Examinations, explained the examination process, including form submission, hall ticket collection, timetable, and result declaration. Dr. Meenal Sumant and Dr. Snober Sataravala briefed on club activities, encouraging student involvement. Mrs. Suhaile Azavedo explained grievance redressal procedures and the "Open Door Policy." Students explored the college library's resources.







Day three commenced with a sanctuary session, followed by an introduction to the Mental Wellbeing Programme by Ms. Swaruti Tamang from the Psychology Department and her student team, elucidating program objectives and methods, including classroom sessions, group therapy, and counseling. Dr. Hasina Shaikh detailed the Student Welfare Scheme's significance and activities such as Earn and Learn and personality development programs. Dr. Meenal Sumant explained the NEP and Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) with a demo video. Ms. Veena Kenchi introduced the Electoral Club, emphasizing democracy and voting rights. Ms. Devinder Kaur stressed library visits' importance, available books, schemes, and online resources. Senior volunteers organized quizzes and games. The day concluded with group visits to the library and Darshan Museum.





Day four featured an engaging session by Mrs. Manjita Kulkarni, NSS Programme Officer, emphasizing community service's personal and social development impact. Mrs. Abhradita Nahvi provided insightful orientation on social outreach, and Mrs. Shanti Fernandes introduced inter and intra-college competitions. First-year BA students experienced Sadhu Vaswani's life and teachings during a Darshan visit.





Day five started with Dr. Vaishali Joshi discussing the transformative changes and interdisciplinary approach of the NEP. Students learned about placement processes, resume building, and interview techniques from the Placement Cell coordinator. Mrs. Abhradita Nahvi detailed activities of the Centre for Women Entrepreneurship (CWE),



fostering budding entrepreneurs. Alumni Association representatives emphasized its role in building professional networks, offering career insights and mentorship. First-year BCOM students explored the Darshan exhibit, gaining insight into Sadhu T. L. Vaswani's life.







The last day began with Dr. Shalini Iyer, Vice Principal, lighting the lamp, followed by an interactive session. First-year students exhibited their talents in dance and vocals. Dr. Meenal Sumant delivered the vote of thanks. Approximately 350 to 380 students attended, followed by refreshments.




• Session on Water Conservation

The CWE, a collaboration between the Department of Business Studies and BBA, fosters entrepreneurial spirit among college students. Events include a lecture on July 27, 2023, by Dr. Sabiha Fazalbhoy, attended by 132 students and 5 faculty, outlining the incubation process and its significance for startups.

St. Laurn Hotel hosted a cake mixing ceremony on November 24, 2023, for CWE students, emphasizing teamwork, cultural appreciation, and event management.



The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) held its Western Regional meet at DY Patil College on December 16, 2023. It included a poster-making competition, highlighting a year's worth of IIC activities.





The CWE and the Department of BBA jointly organised a workshop on Entrepreneurship Skill Attitude and Behaviour Development, presided over by Ms. Sapna Bang, the founder, and CEO of Chatak Tokree.



CWE, in partnership with the Department of Commerce, hosted a workshop on "Design Thinking, Critical Thinking, and Innovation Design" on February 22, 2024. 


'National Reading Day'

Students shared their experiences of social service and how Dada's teachings influenced their lives. In honor of Dada J. P. Vaswani's 105th Birthday Celebrations, Anjali Week



unfolded from July 25 to August 5, 2023, featuring Hindi, Marathi, and English Declamation, along with Anjali Geet competitions. Another special Sanctuary session marked Dada J. P. Vaswani's 105th birthday on July 28, 2023. Supriya Dandnaik, an alumna, shared how his message of 'stop all killings' inspired her animal rights work, followed by 'Guru Vandana,' a dance tribute to the revered founder. On November 24, 2023,



students presented the theatrical performance "Sahib Mera Ek Hai" at Sadhu Vaswani Mission, honoring Rev. Sadhu T.L. Vaswani's 144th Birthday. The play depicted a celestial encounter between Saint Kabir and Dada J.P. Vaswani, sharing sentiments of oneness, benevolence, and compassion for their sacred Masters. Witnessing the life of

Symposium on "Value-based Education in the context of NEP 2020"

On January 29, 2024, the College, along with the Department of Education, SPPU, and Sadhu Vaswani Institute of Management Studies, hosted a symposium titled "Value-based Education in the context of NEP 2020," commemorating the 90th year of the Mira movement in value-based education.
