**Semester: II Course Type: Economics Elective Course Title: Indian Industrial Environment**

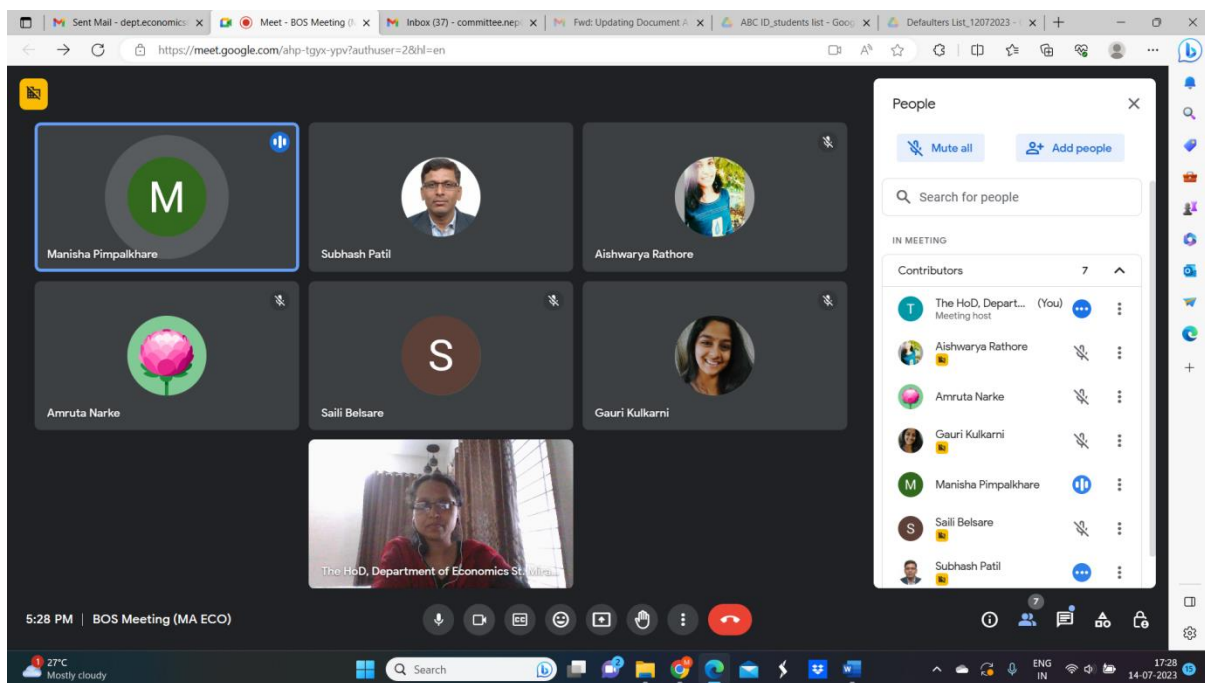
1. Dr. Meenal Sumant highlighted the importance of the course and all the major inclusions.




