
At the end of this course, the learner will be able to:

Guidelines for On Job Training (OJT)	120 hrs
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student must start the OJT/Internship immediately after Semester-II examination during the summer vacation 2. Student are expected to complete the English related work/project within 120 hours assigned by organization (company/ industry/ consultancy/ institution) 3. The internship work may involve English related assignment(s) OR the maintenance of existing project OR the design/development of new project OR equivalent work 4. College should assign the mentors/guides for students to monitor the progress throughout the OJT 5. Students have to submit the weekly progress report duly signed by the concern authorities of organization to the assigned mentor 6. At the end of OJT, students should prepare the documentation and submit a report to the college in prescribed format 7. After completion, the final presentation and documentation will be evaluated by the examination panel as per the University norms
