On the occasion of World AIDS Awareness Day, the Department of NSS, St. Mira's College for Girls, in collaboration with the 15 students and NSS volunteers of Sarva Sewa Sangh and Christ College, organized a series of awareness activities on 2nd December. The programme began with a pledge taken by students and staff, affirming their commitment to spread awareness, promote compassion, and stand against stigma and discrimination related to HIV/AIDS.

This was followed by an impactful street play performed on 2nd December during the Morning Assembly at the Sanctuary, attended by senior college students and teachers. The performance highlighted the various forms of discrimination faced by individuals living with HIV/AIDS—including mistreatment at home, biased behaviour in workplaces, and denial or delay of proper care in hospitals. The play concluded with a message on legal protections provided under Indian law and the ethical duty of humanity to treat every individual with dignity, respect, and empathy.

To reinforce these messages, the street play was followed by question—answer session. The session provided an open platform for students to clarify doubts, understand the scientific facts about HIV transmission, and engage in informed dialogue.

The program was attended by 300 people.

Overall, the initiative created strong awareness, encouraged sensitivity, and strengthened the spirit of social responsibility among the student community.
